#### DOMINICAN STUDENTS ON PLACEMENT AT HOLY CROSS

During the summer months, our Dominican students for the priesthood take the opportunity to visit our different foundations and experience the different aspects of the life of our Order, as well as enriching our life and ministry by their presence and example. This month, we welcome Br Bede Mullens OP, having just completed his first year of studies. We hope to also welcome Br Thomas Mannion OP, but his arrival is delayed by a family bereavement. They will mostly be working with Fr David on a project focussed on discipleship, as we develop the reflections *Share the Fruits*. Please make them feel welcome and engage with the initiatives we're developing.

#### DEVELOPING THE FRASSATI CENTRE

We have been busy developing plans for a new pastoral centre here at Holy Cross – *The Frassati Centre for Preaching and Evangelisation*. This would seek to breathe new life into the original church buildings that we knew as the 'Holy Cross Centre'. We've assembled £180k so far to develop these buildings, and we are seeking to embark on a major fundraising project as we look towards our bicentenary. **Update this week:** we are grateful to all those who have assisted us in obtaining quotations that we will now present to the Provincial and his Council during their meeting in August for approval and decision. Hopefully we will get things started very soon.

#### COMMUNION FOR THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

We have a small and dedicated team of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, who visit the sick and housebound with Holy Communion each week. Each of these clients is visited by the Parish Priest once each month, in accordance with arrangements. In order to comply with safeguarding regulations, and with GDPR (data protection), we need to ensure this is done carefully. We will soon develop a form for visits, especially those that need to be arranged outside of the boundaries of the parish. We are very committed to ensuring that all our vulnerable parishioners stay in touch with us. We just have to be sure it is safe for everyone.
