#### **SUMMER MONTHS AT HOLY CROSS**

Now that the academic year has concluded, we look forward to another glorious English Summer! During the next few months, the Dominican Fathers will take the opportunity for some holiday time, as well as opportunity for retreat and training. #### DEVELOPING THE FRASSATI CENTRE

We have been busy developing plans for a new pastoral centre here at Holy Cross – *The Frassati Centre for Preaching and Evangelisation*. This would seek to breathe new life into the original church buildings that we knew as the 'Holy Cross Centre'. We've assembled £180k so far to develop these buildings, and we are seeking to embark on a major fundraising project as we look towards our bicentenary. **Update this week:** we are grateful to all those who have assisted us in obtaining quotations that we will now present to the Provincial and his Council during their meeting in August for approval and decision. Hopefully we will get things started very soon.

## SOLEMNITY OF ST DOMINIC - THURSDAY 8 AUGUST 2019

We invite you to join us for the celebrations of the Solemnity of St Dominic, as we ask the intercession of Our Holy Father in the 200<sup>th</sup> Year of our mission and our time of renewal.
