We have been busy developing plans for a new pastoral centre here at Holy Cross – *The Frassati Centre for Preaching and Evangelisation*. We've assembled £180k so far to develop these buildings, and we are seeking to embark on a major fundraising project as we look towards our bicentenary. <u>Update this week:</u> we are finalising details last quotations for the works and we are looking forward to presenting these to the Provincial Council for decision and commissioning the works. *There will be more news during June as our proposals are developed Please do pray for the success of the project.*
