#### LETTER CONCERNING IICSA AND THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

IICSA is the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse and is working to establish the truth about the grave wrongs done to children in the past, and ensuring that best practice is in place to prevent this in the future. IICSA has been investigating the practices of the Catholic Church. During the past week, IICSA has concluded hearing evidence about current safeguarding standards and practice in the Catholic Church and assessing the effectiveness of these. *Please see copies of a letter from +Patrick our Bishop that outline his reflections on the matter*. We pray that lessons will be learned well.

We are making progress with architectural drawings and contractors are collaborating. We have already begun to address some of the drainage and damp issues in the building, and to install some new windows. An important step forward is the development of a vision for the apostolate of this new initiative.

## PROGRESS WITH GRANTS AND MAINTENANCE

We have been delighted during the past week to receive two significant grants towards our 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary projects. The first, for £7.5K, is from Leicestershire Historic Churches Trust, and will be used to address problems with the roof, stonework, and windows. The second, for £750, is from the J Reginald Corah Foundation, for developments in the Frassati Centre. Please continue to pray for the success of our appeals.
