CORONAVIRUS - WHAT ARE WE DOING AT HOLY CROSS?

Our church is closed to the public, Masses are celebrated without congregations present, and all Masses are livestreamed at the usual times -please see our facebook - https://www.facebook.com/holycrossleicester/ The Faithful are asked to make a spiritual communion during Mass, formulae for which are provided

In the meantime, the following things will **remain in place**:

- The Dominican Fathers continue to offer pastoral care of the dying, and chaplaincy support to the LRI and other hospitals, in collaboration with the arrangements made by the University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) NHS Trust.
- Marriages and baptisms are suspended at this time, except in extreme emergencies, funerals are subject to guidance and can be discussed with us by email leicester@english.op.org this is by far the best way to contact us. We are gradually catching up with everyone by phone, but please be aware we are dealing with an extraordinary number of calls
- Our Facebook page is the principal vehicle for communication at present.

We are very pleased that many of you have continued to follow us on Facebook, both taking part in the services and keeping in contact. THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

It is not possible to provide for the Sacrament of Reconciliation under the present restrictions, and this is not a sacrament that can be livestreamed or administered on the phone. Instead, an Act of Perfect Contrition can be made. This is essentially your usual formula for the act of contrition made under the special conditions. We will provide further opportunities to follow services of reconciliation online.
