A MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

Dear brothers and sisters,

Just a quick note this month to let you know about times of services for Christmas. This information is also available on our website. Christmas this year falls on a Monday: on Sunday 24th December we will have the usual morning Masses at 8 and 10.30, as well as the vigil on the Saturday night. On the Sunday evening there will be a children's nativity play at 5.45 p.m. followed by the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 6.10. There will be no 7 p.m. Mass. Midnight Mass will be at 10 p.m. On Christmas Day there will be Masses at 8 a.m., 10.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m., but no evening Mass. There will be no tea/coffee after Masses on the Sunday or Christmas Day, and during the week after Christmas there will be no evening Masses. Everything will go back to normal on Saturday 30th December. A separate leaflet with all these times will soon be available to take home.

ADVENT FAIR – The Parish Advent Fair will take place this year on Sunday 10th December. We would be very grateful for raffle prizes and bottles for the bottle stall – please hand these to any member of the community, or Nick the Sacristan. And please sell as many raffle tickets as you can!

MISSION PREACHER – Fr Clifton Harries OP from our Dominican Community in Jamaica preached to us about his work there, and took up a second collection which raised nearly £2,000. We are enormously grateful for your generosity.

RECONCILIATION SERVICE – There will be a service of reconciliation on Saturday 18th December at 3 p.m., with an opportunity for individual confessions. Do consider taking this opportunity during the penitential season of Advent. **THE BISHOP IS COMING!** – Patrick, Bishop of Nottingham, will celebrate the 10.30 Mass for us on the morning of Sunday 17th December. It would be wonderful if our church was even fuller than usual at that Mass, and there will be an opportunity to meet the Bishop after Mass in the Frassati Centre.

DAY FOR READERS – Fr John will give a day for readers on Saturday 2nd December. If you read at Mass, either on Sundays or weekdays, or would like to start, you are asked to come to this meeting, which will run from 1.45 to 3.30 p.m. in the Frassati Centre and will look at the readings for Advent and Christmastide.

SACRAMENTS

- Infant Baptisms, Marriages, Becoming Catholic: Please apply to the parish office by email.
- Visiting the Sick: If you would like a visit, either send an email or leave a telephone message with your name, tel. no. & address.
- **First Communion**: classes will begin soon for children who are not receiving catechism at school. Please ask one of the priests for a green form, or e-mail as above. Once the classes start, it will be too late to enrol new children, so please do this by the end of the month.

The Dominican priests continue to offer **pastoral care to the LRI**, in collaboration with the University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) NHS Trust. **If you or a relative are in hospital, please ask the nurse to inform the hospital chaplain. If someone is dying, ask the duty nurse to call the Catholic chaplain** – do not call yourself.

PARISH GROUPS

SCRIPTURE STUDY: the group has started up again and is going very well, but new members are always welcome. This autumn we have begun reading from the Book of the Apocalypse.We meet on Tuesday evenings at 7.45 for about an hour, and all are welcome, including older children if accompanied by a parent or guardian.
